1. Mini Contracts Consent Agenda for Action Items 4.1.1. through 4.1.6.

4.1.1. Approval of Special Education Services Contracts 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreements between Sachem Central School District and Central Islip Union Free School District, Connetquot School District, Longwood Central School District, Middle Country Central School District, Patchogue-Medford Union Free School District, Sayville School District, Three Village Central School District and William Floyd Union Free School District to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Sachem Central School District. 4.1.2. <u>Approval of Special Education Services Agreement with Rockville Centre</u> UFSD 2015-16
