

Using PowerMedia Plus to Upload files:

- Go to <http://www.powermediaplus.com>
 - Audio Files must be .mp3
 - Video files must be .m4v (mpeg-4 video)
- Log in and Click the Podcast Tab
- Start a new Podcast
 - Publish a Podcast
 - Checkbox for sharing
- Add Episodes to Podcast
 - My Podcasts
 - Add Episodes
- Copy the link for either RSS or iTunes (or both) to make the podcast available to anyone, even those without a PM Plus account 😊

Subscribe to Podcast

- Log into your PowerMedia Plus Account
- Click on Podcasts
- Choose "My Podcasts" and Select the Podcast you created (or use search to link to someone else's podcast)
- Click the link next to "Subscribe to this Podcast"
- You can also copy the link to your "subscribe to podcast" from PowerMedia Plus and send it to others or post that link on one of your school's webpages (so others do not need to log into PM Plus to subscribe)
- Copy Podcast(s) onto ipod for portable listening
