1. Connect the SMART Board:

- Projector
- Laptop
- SMART board

2. Orient the SMART Board:

- Press the four targets to properly align the Board

3. Navigate (while using the SMART Board – do not touch the keyboard or mouse) to the Instruct share folder. Select wmacintosh/apisano/kgalgano > share > smartboard > samplevideo (varies with school).

4. Cycle between SMART board (only), laptop (only) and both.

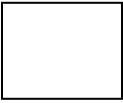
5. Open Internet Explorer. Use the onscreen keyboard (underneath the eraser) to type: www.smarttech.com.

6. Leaving smarttech.com up, take a few minutes to play with the pens and eraser.

7. Use the floating tool bar. Take several minutes to explore some of its features.

8. If it is not already running (ie from using the camera icon), open up the Notebook software.



- Open up the Gallery
- Select Essentials for Educators
- Search a topic that interests you.
- Bring in a gallery element
- Resize the object
- Add a new page (+)
- Play with the tool bar (page 10 in your handout)

9. Go back to smarttech.com:

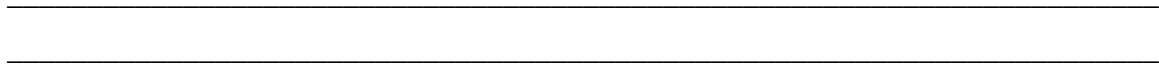


- Select Education > Education Resources > Notebook software activities > United States > Subject & Grade level. Search for a topic of interest to you.
