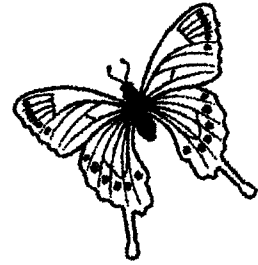


# The Chippewa Memorial Garden



A labor of love and healing, our Memorial Garden was built after the loss of 3 wonderful people – a teacher, our secretary and a former student, all within a year. The Children's Garden area had been demolished to expand the library. Wishing to remember our friends in a special way, Chippewa's families, friends and staff created the very symbolic Memorial Garden. It was designed with the help of the engineer overseeing the construction in our building, who was also touched by all our losses. Before we had completed the garden, we were again faced with the loss of our head custodian. With heavy hearts, we were able to complete the garden and dedicate it in the fall of 2004. We have since added a butterfly garden area and four planting boxes for the children from the original garden. The floor of the sitting area holds the bricks inscribed with the many messages of love, peace and encouragement. Walk around by the side entrance and sit awhile.

We are currently accepting brick orders for Chippewa's Memorial Garden. Bricks will be inserted permanently into the sitting area in the garden. They give our families the opportunity to honor a loved one or leave a message of peace or inspiration for visitors to the garden.

The cost of the brick is \$50.00. The brick will be engraved with up to 3 lines of 14 characters or spaces per line. Use the brick below to design yours. Send this form back to Chippewa to the attention of Mrs. Annunziato, with your check made out to "Chippewa" and we will order your personal brick.

**\*Please note: The engraving company will only take orders of 10 bricks or more. Therefore it may take a while for your brick to be placed in the garden.**
