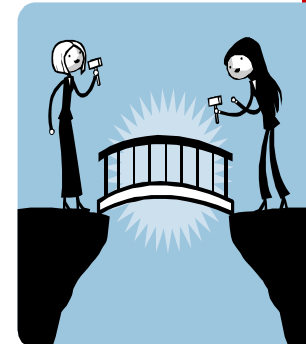

The Sachem High School— Suffolk County

Community College BRIDGE Program

Sachem High School seniors have an opportunity to enroll in college courses at the Ammerman campus of Suffolk County Community College and earn credit that may be used at SCCC, a SUNY college/university or other public or private institutions. Students must complete high school graduation requirements at their high school, but may choose additional academic or elective courses from a list of college programs.

The BRIDGE Program allows students to earn college credit while experiencing coursework on a college campus. This option further expands the many academic choices students have in the Sachem Central School District and assists in preparing them for collegiate work.



Program Features

- Students choose course(s) from approved list of options
- Students pay tuition to SCCC
- Students receive SCCC transcript for course(s) taken at SCCC
- Students may be released from Sachem High School after 5 periods of classes
- Students provide own transportation to SCCC
- SCCC credits are transferable to other post-secondary institutions

Selection Criteria

- Students must submit application by deadline in order to participate
- Students must take the Computerized Placement Test to identify their level of proficiency in reading, English, arithmetic and algebra
- Students must verify that they can arrange their own transportation to SCCC
- Students must enroll in at least five periods of classes at Sachem High School
