

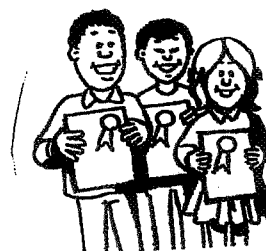
Renaissance Program

The goal of the Renaissance program is to provide an environment that promotes social, physical, and emotional growth in our school and community. Renaissance stresses academic excellence to show our students who they are and who they can be. Students are motivated to reach individual goals of academic performance, attendance and behavior and quarterly incentives are given for earning a card. Renaissance is not about being the best; Renaissance is about being the best you can be!

Criteria for the Renaissance Program:

A student must achieve:

- 70 or above average
- No discipline referrals
- No more than 4 latenesses
- No more than 4 absences
- No failing grades

Recognition Awards

100% Homework Award: One student in each grade level is chosen each month for completing 100% of his or her homework.

Student of the Month: A student is nominated by a faculty or staff member. The student will have his or her name announced over the P.A. system; receive a letter of recognition, a prize (movie passes, etc.) and a formal presentation of the award by principal at a breakfast for students and parents.

Class of the Week: Faculty and staff members have the opportunity to nominate their classes based on academic and social acts of kindness. The class will receive a certificate of recognition, announcement over the P.A. system, and a bagel breakfast.

Renaissance Club: Any renaissance cardholder can participate in our community service club. Activities include Samoset cares, Adopt-a-Family, and Red Cross Fundraisers.

Faculty Member of the Month: The staff member will have his or her name announced over the P.A. system; receive a recognition certificate, a free breakfast, and the staff recognition parking spot.
