<u>Forces and Interactions</u>: Students will focus on Newton's three laws of motion.

<u>Life in Ecosystems</u>: Students will be introduced to life cycles, inherited and acquired traits, adaptations, and the fossil record and how all of those things impact the diversity of life on Earth.

<u>Weather and Climate Patterns</u>: Students will explore and learn about patterns in weather, climate, seasons, and weather hazards.
