This will take you to the page containing the Parent Login. At the login screen, you will need to enter your confidential username and password provided in a previous mailing. If you do not remember receiving this letter, have misplaced it or do not remember your username, please call 631-471-1360 or e-mail esdparentportal@sachem.edu. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT.

If you do not know your password you can have it reset by clicking on the 'forgot password link' from the login page and entering your email address in the email address field and pressing the "Reset Password" button. You will receive an email back that will provide you with your username and a link that will allow you to reset your password.
