

Accessing the Parent Portal

The Parent Portal is a very important resource available to you to make sure your student is making adequate progress. It is a internet-based highly secure, application through which you can view details of your student's school records including their grades for each class. To access the Parent Portal, you need a device with an internet connection. For the best browsing experience, we recommend Safari 5.0, Google Chrome 27, or Internet Explorer 11, or later. To access the Portal, go to the District home page at

sachem.edu, scroll down to Family Resources and click, then click on eSchool Parent Portal. Once there, follow the instructions provided. Once you log into the Portal, click on your student's ID number in blue. Use the menu on the top to find the information you are looking for. For your student's classes and grades, choose gradebook. If you need more guidance, please call Ms. Conte, who will be able to talk you through the steps.




