- All entrants must be currently in the school grades 1-8.
- Size: Minimum poster size 8 ½" x 11"
- Materials: markers, crayons, pastels, paints.
- Each entry must depict a recycling theme such as composting, electronics recycling, waste to energy conversion, etc.
- Artwork must be students own work.
- Only one student per poster
