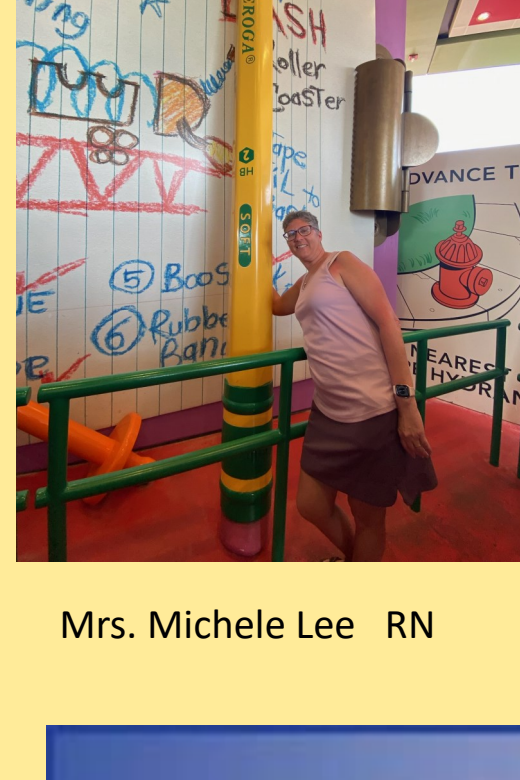

Sports Physicals for Athletes being offered for the 2023-2024 School Year

A copy of the physical will be given to the student the next day for you to upload to final forms

Sports Physical forms can be downloaded on the athletic website <http://www.sachem.edu/departments/athletics> or picked up in the Nurse's Office.

Health history (pages 3, 4, 5) must be completed and signed by Parent / Guardian **prior** to the Physical.

It is the responsibility of the child and parent to submit the appropriate paperwork to the school nurse in a timely fashion.

Please contact the building nurse with any questions related to your child's sports physical.

Sport Clearances

All sports will be cleared

through Final Forms only.

Do not give paperwork to your Coach, Secretaries or Administrators. Do not mail it.

Only upload physicals to final forms.

Do Not wait until the last minute to try and get cleared, the nurses **Will Not** be able to handle last minute clearances.

It is the responsibility of the child and parent

to upload paperwork on final forms.

School Physicals:

New York State requires all 9th & 11th grade students and new entries to the Sachem District have a physical on file with the school.

If your child has had his/her physical, but has not turned in the physicians form, please do so **as soon as possible**.

Students who have not turned in documentation of a physical will be examined by the school physician.

Sachem School District children will be screened for the following

Grade 9: Scoliosis (Boys only)

Grade 11: Distance & Near Vision Screening , Hearing Screening

IMMUNIZATIONS

All students must be immunized by NYS regulations.

Student entering 12th grade **REQUIRE**

a "Meningitis A" vaccine after the age of 16.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS!

****If a Doctor or Specialist requests a student not participate in physical education or sports, the NURSE must receive a note from that doctor before they will be allowed to return to gym or sports****

****If you weren't cleared to play physical education when the school year ended in June, we need the clearance from the Physician to allow you to play or an updated medical note to keep you out in September****

****If a student requires any medications, *even over the counter medications* (Advil, Tylenol...etc.)**

the Nurse needs a prescription from the doctor.

Under NYS Nurse's Laws, the Nurse may not administer any medications without a prescription.**
