## 1.a. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and</u> Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the contract between Sachem Central School District and Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC), Suffolk County Chapter, to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program.
