a. Approval of Agreement with Crest Hollow Country Club

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the revised agreement between Sachem Central School District and Crest Hollow Country Club for the Sachem High School North Senior Prom being held on June 26, 2014 to be paid by the students. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

b. Approval of Agreement with Sagamore Children's Psychiatric Center

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Sagamore Children's Psychiatric Center to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a facility to students enrolled at the facility during the school year. The School District will pay the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

c. Approval of Special Education Services Agreement with Sayville UFSD

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Sayville Union Free School District to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Sayville Union Free School District. Sayville UFSD shall be entitled to bill Sachem CSD in accordance with Education Law Section 3602-c and the Regulations or Rules of the Commissioner of Education. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

d. <u>Approval of Agreement with EDGE Document Solutions</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and EDGE Document Solutions to provide digital presentment of the NYS Parent Reports and Third Party Assessments for a period of twelve months and during this period, unlimited viewing of the reports is provided. EDGE will also design and develop a web page to meet the school district

requirements. Sachem School District will have the option to provide EDGE with Parent Reports and Third Party Assessments from previous years which will be hosted. The cost is not to exceed \$1,300.00. This agreement shall be in effect for the period May 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

e. <u>Approval of Agreement with Smithtown Hearing Services</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Smithtown Hearing Services to provide FM Trainer Calibration Evaluations. The fee for this service is \$75 per evaluation. This agreement shall be from September 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013. This will be paid from the Office of Student Services budget. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

f. Approval of Agreement with Ascent: A School for Individuals with Autism

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Ascent: A School for Individuals with Autism to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a facility to students enrolled at the facility during the school year. The School District will pay the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

g. <u>Approval of Agreement with Madonna Heights</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Madonna Heights to provide instruction, related services and/or a facility to students during the school year. The tuition rate will be set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

h. Approval of Subscription Agreement with eSchoolData

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the subscription agreement between Sachem Central School District and eSchoolData, a student management system that stores all student information such as transcripts, progress reports, etc. The 2013-14 annual subscription license fee is \$162,317.34 for 14,783 students based on \$10.98 per student fee. i. <u>Approval of Agreement with Herff Jones</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Herff Jones to provide Class of 2014 Yearbooks for Sachem High School East. The cost for this service is \$42,800 for 600 copies to be paid for by the students. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

j. <u>Approval of Agreement with Mazz Marketing</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the contract between Sachem Central School District and Mazz Marketing, Inc. to provide a one day seminar on October 22, 2013, or such other date mutually agreed upon by the parties during the 2013-14 school year to the parents, students and staff of Sachem High School East concerning the college athletic recruiting process. The fee for this service is \$750.00. The term of the agreement shall be for the period from October 1, 2013 to October 31, 2013. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

k. Approval of Renewal with Transfinder

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the renewal with Transfinder, a bus routing and scheduling system, for annual technical support and upgrade for Routefinder pro License at a renewal cost of \$3,750.00 and Infofinder *le* License at a renewal cost of \$2,400.00 for the 2013-2014 school year.

I. Approval of Agreement with Reviewed Costs, Inc. D/B/A Industrial U.I. Services

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Reviewed Costs, Inc., d/b/a Industrial U.I. Services to provide unemployment insurance cost control services. This agreement shall be in effect July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. The fee for this service is \$7,800.00 in four (4) equal installments of \$1,950.00 to be paid quarterly. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

m. Approval of Agreement with Fire Island UFSD

The approximate value of this donation is \$3,500.00.

Approval of Budget Transfers \$50,000 or Greater

by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve one budget transfer of \$50,000 or greater:

One transfer for \$2,795,654.51 is to balance teacher salary codes for year end.

Approval of Enrollment in The Omni Group, Preferred Provider Program (P3)

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Ms. Ahearn, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve enrollment in Omni's Preferred Provider Program (P3) effective July 1, 2013. Our annual bill for administration costs would be reduced from \$34,000/year to approximately \$11,580/year, a savings of 76%. All existing accounts with employees would be honored, including any accounts with non-P3 providers. Sachem School District is only responsible for those accounts with non-P3 providers. Omni will bill the P3 providers for the balance of their fees. There are no additional fees and no reduction in earnings can be deducted from the employee's investment return at any time by the providers.
